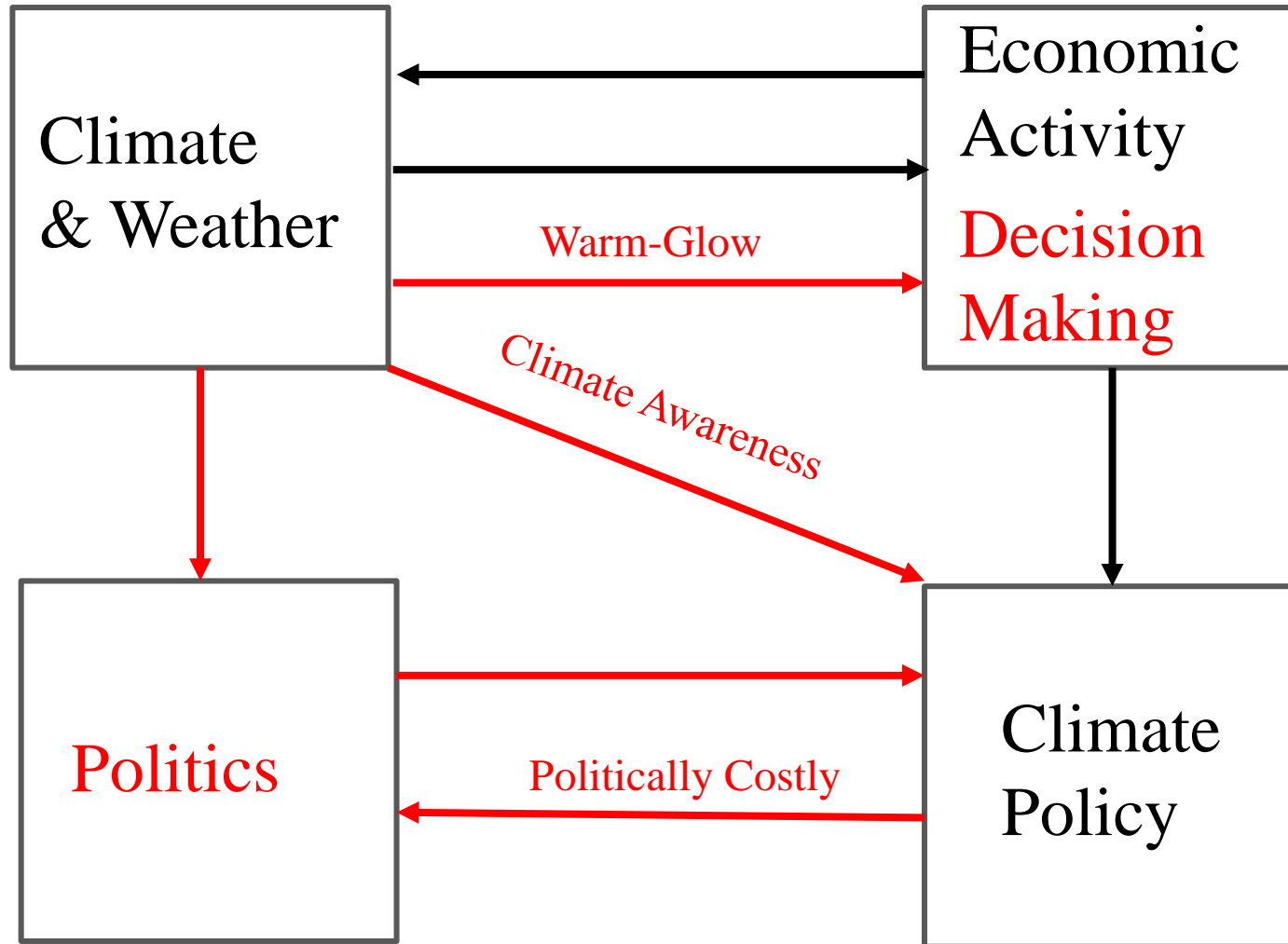

# THE ROLE OF WARM-GLOW IN THE PREVENTION OF CLIMATE CHANGE

- How public concern about climate change may drive market penetration of carbon free fuels
- Warm glow parameter
- Willing to pay for clean electricity
- Endogenous technical change

# CLIMATE CHANGE AWARENESS: EMPIRICAL EVIDENCE FOR THE EUROPEAN UNION

- What drives concern about climate change
  - Economic
  - Demographic
  - Political (social trust)
  - Direct experience
- How should we measure direct experience?
  - Rational (climate)
  - Weather
  - Indoor air temperature
  - Framing

# ARE CLIMATE CHANGE POLICIES POLITICALLY COSTLY?

- Political costs of climate policies
  - Policy stringency
  - Economic conditions (fuel prices)
  - Role of market forces
  - Direct experience
- Things to think about
  - Did we miss a pandemic window?
