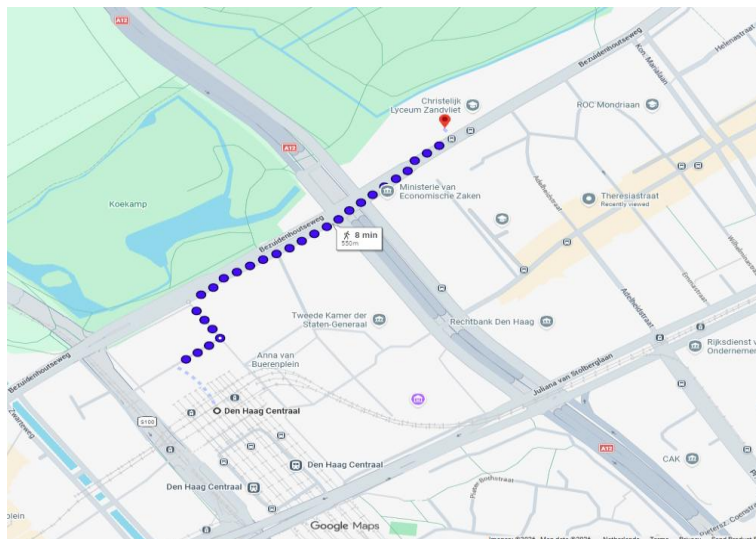
## Venue & Transportation Information

The 22nd EUROFRAME Conference will take place on 12 June 2026 in The Hague, Netherlands, hosted by CPB Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis.

### CPB Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis

The CPB Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis is an independent Dutch government economic research institute and a leading authority on economic policy in the Netherlands. It is located in the central business district of The Hague, close to major transport hubs, making the venue highly accessible by public transport for conference participants. It is approximately 600 meters (about a 5-to-10-minute walk) from Den Haag Centraal Station.

### Arrival by Train: Den Haag Centraal Station (main station in The Hague)

- Den Haag Centraal Station is easily reachable by international trains, for some routes, by direct train plus a domestic transfer in the Netherlands.
- Among the most popular international rail connections to Den Haag Centraal are: Brussels, Antwerp, Paris, London, Lille, Cologne, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt am Main, Berlin, Hamburg, Zurich, and Basel.
- The main international train operators serving these routes include:

- [NS International](#) (booking and connecting services for international rail travel to and from the Netherlands)

### **Arrival by Air: Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS)**

Schiphol Airport is the main international gateway to the Netherlands.

- **From Schipol Airport to The Hague:**

- **Train** (Recommended):
  - Direct trains from Schiphol to Den Haag Centraal
  - Travel time: ~30 minutes
  - Frequency: Every 10–15 minutes
  - Operated by [Nederlandse Spoorwegen](#)
  - Tickets and payment: Participants do not need to buy a separate paper ticket if they prefer not to. They can simply check in and check out with a contactless debit card, credit card, or mobile wallet at the yellow NS gates or card readers. It is also possible to purchase a physical single-use train ticket from the ticket machines at Schiphol Airport.
  - A one-way standard 2<sup>nd</sup> class train ticket from Schiphol Airport to Den Haag Centraal costs: €11.10
- **Taxi:**
  - Travel time: ~30–40 minutes (depending on traffic)
  - Taxis can be hailed in-person at the airport, or via Uber or Bolt
  - Price per way ranges from €50 - €150

### **Practical Tips for Participants**

- Use an OV-chipkaart or contactless debit/credit card for all public transport (check-in and check-out required)
- Trains are generally the fastest and most reliable option for intercity travel
- Download *Google Maps*, *NS* app or *9292* for real-time travel planning
- Trains can be crowded during peak hours (07:30–09:00 and 16:30–18:00), plan accordingly
- The Netherlands is generally cashless, card payments are widely accepted
